Southfield High's Hardware and Networking needs were basic. There would be 4 computer stations in the Student Store. The fastest computer would be the Back-Office Server and become data source for the other PC's on the store's own network (LAN). The

remaining 3 Computers would get POS Hardware as needed such as Cash Drawer, Barcode Scanner, Customer Display Pole, a programmable POS Keyboard with color Key Caps, and a Receipt Printer. Not all PC's (e.g. Cookie or Hot Pocket stations) would get a Scanner or Receipt Printer.

The Budget was addressed by utilizing any pre-existing computers, monitors, and office printers that the district had available which met the hardware requirements specified in POSitive's web site. Note: There will always be DECA group promotion on Software and Hardware.
